The Remembrance Tour in Berlin is part of the project “**nEUres - Nonviolent European Resistance**” that aims to remember and to reflect upon the forms of civil and nonviolent resistance against Nazi that took place, e.g. individual/collective stories of solidarity, support to politically and racially persecuted, fleeing soldiers and other war victims; the role of women, clandestine press, peasants 'and workers 'struggles, resistance of Jews and others persecuted in concentration camps; the role of teachers, intellectuals and religious people.
