

## The project «Nonviolent European Resistance» was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

6 events have been carried out within this project:

### Event 1

**Participation:** The event involved 16 citizens, including 7 participants from the city of Verona (**Italy**), 2 participants from the city of Zaragoza (**Spain**), 2 participants from the city of Hódmezővásárhely (**Hungary**), 2 participants from the city of Resita (**Romania**), 2 participants from the city of Bruxelles (**Belgium**), 1 participant from the city of Wien (**Austria**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Verona (Verona, **Italy**), from 29/11/2019 to 01/12/2019

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to exchange and share knowledge on the theme, and activate thematic Work Tables (WT) for further developing Guidelines and educational-training materials for action implementation (3 coordinating tables + min. 7 for the analysis of selected individual/collective stories of nonviolent EU Resistance).

### Event 2

**Participation:** The event involved 37 citizens, including 14 participants from the city of Fiumicino (**Italy**), 5 participants from the city of Zaragoza (**Spain**), 6 participants from the city of Hódmezővásárhely (**Hungary**), 6 participants from the city of Resita (**Romania**), 5 participants from the city of Wien (**Austria**), 1 participant from the city of Prilep (**North Macedonia**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Fiumicino (**RM, Italy**), from 22/09/2020 to 24/09/2020

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to transfer knowledge to educators in each country. Participants experienced an intercultural environment, shared good practices among peers and acquired tools to guide and support youth in further implementation and, more generally, in their empowerment in Civil Society, exploring the dimensions of youth thinking in the reflection on nazi-fascism, WWII and the births of EU integration. The modules deepened have been: historical phenomenon, project methodological approach to EU Remembrance, how to favour among youth a constructive elaborative thinking around Civil Society and civic participation in contemporary age, how to guide/accompany youths within and beyond project implementation becoming "memory militants".

### Event 3

**Participation:** The event involved 209 citizens, including 52 participants from **Italy**, including 45 participants from the city of Zaragoza (**Spain**), including 72 participants from the city of Resita (**Romania**), including 13 participants from the city of Hódmezővásárhely (**Hungary**), including 19 participants from **Austria**, including 8 participants from **North Macedonia**

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in **IT/ES/AT/RO/HU/MK** from 01/10/2020 to 31/01/2021

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to implement nationally at youth aggregation places engaging Educators in transferring nEUres knowledge under the supervision of tutors, and involving Youths also as beneficiaries of "Pills of" Multimedial/Digital Storytelling and Photojournalism, useful to reinterpret further project experiences (Nonviolent Resistance Tours) and build new Youth narratives around past and present civil engagement on the forms of nonviolent organized/not-organized Resistance: individual/collective stories of solidarity, support and concrete aid to political and racial persecuted, fleeing soldiers and other war victims; the role of women, clandestine press, peasants' and workers' struggles, resistance of Jews and others persecuted in concentration camps; the role of teachers, intellectuals and religious men/women.

#### **Event 4**

**Participation:** The event involved 52 citizens, including 16 participants from the city of Fiumicino (**Italy**), 7 participants from the city of Zaragoza (**Spain**), 7 participants from the city of Hódmezővásárhely (**Hungary**), 8 participants from the city of Resita (**Romania**), 7 participants from the city of Wien (**Austria**), 7 participant from the city of Prilep (**North Macedonia**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Wien (Wien, **AT**), Berlin (Berlin, **DE**), Florence (Florence, **IT**), Sant'Anna (Stazzema, **IT**), from 01/06/2021 to 31/07/2021

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to ensure that selected participants would travel to the most significant European sites for what concerns Nonviolent Resistance to nazi-fascism. Each destination hosted 2 groups of participants from 2 sending organizations and will include different visit sites, for a total of 3 Tours (IT/AT/DE), including visits to museums, routes, homes, places of the memory of nonviolent resistance visited by youths and adults.

#### **Event 5**

**Participation:** The event involved 97 citizens, including 17 participants from **Italy**, including 24 participants from the city of Zaragoza (**Spain**), including 14 participants from the city of Resita (**Romania**), including 15 participants from the city of Hódmezővásárhely (**Hungary**), including 18 participants from **Austria**, including 9 participants from **North Macedonia**

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in **IT/ES/AT/RO/HU/MK**, from 01/08/2021 to 11/12/2021

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to carry out at national level by the youths previously involved, tutored by educators as facilitators of a reflection on what experienced so far, to be shared with other local peers. Exchanging experiencing, discussing and reinterpreting stories and events, planning an action for present engagement in Civil Society through digital/multimedial storytelling productions, creating and setting up exhibitions for National Info Days; identify new dangerous trends (challenges) and positive potential (opportunities) of youths in local/national/EU contexts, considering the risks of a denial of fundamental human rights already faced by past generations during nazi-fascism, compared with EU values and the courageous reaction of a civil nonviolent Resistance.

#### **Event 6**

**Participation:** The event involved 55 citizens, including 48 participants from **Italy**, including 1 participant from the city of Zaragoza (**Spain**), including 1 participant from the city of Resita (**Romania**), including 2 participants from the city of Hódmezővásárhely (**Hungary**), including 1 participant from the city of Wien (**Austria**), including 1 participant from Bruxelles (**Belgium**), including 1 participant from the city of Prilep (**North Macedonia**)

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Verona (Verona, **Italy**) on 13/12/2021

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to hold a public final conference of the project where public debate would be encouraged among participants, experts, scholars, relevant institutional/non institutional stakeholders, towards a nEUres continuation as Volunteering/Solidarity project, also in the framework of ESC and to allow for greater participation in attendance, this activity was reshaped, and the change of venue to Verona, where the national center of the Nonviolent Movement is located, and thanks to the network of Universal Civil Service in place with the Don Calabria Institute, allowed the final conference to take place in a large space suitable for a greater and safer participation and involvement of young people.
